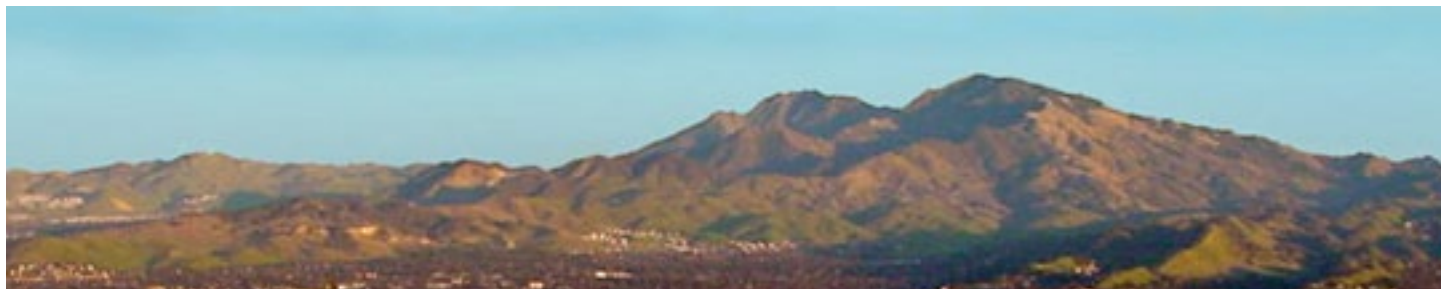

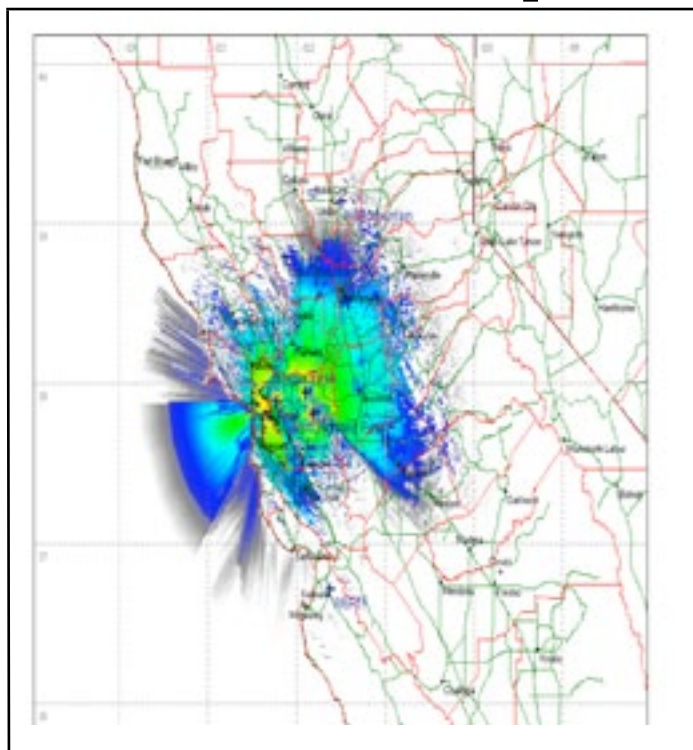
## **Coverage Map of the WA6HAM VHF Repeater**

The system covers the San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose area as well as the Sacramento - San Joaquin Valleys of Northern California.
